- We'll meet at 8AM at a location To Be Determined, divide into teams and travel to and fish the assigned water.
- We'll reconvene at Noon at the same location where (weather permitting) for \$5 you can join us for a cookout.
- Most of the streams we are currently considering for surveys are tributaries of the Merrimack River. If you have any suggestions on other streams, please let me know.
